INPATIENT PROGRAMS

Children (ages 3–12)

A behavior motivation treatment model is used which includes enhanced expressive therapy and family communication.

Adolescents (ages 13–17)

Units are separated by gender. Young persons with emotional and behavioral difficulties are provided skills for identifying and coping with these emotions as well as strategies for improving relationships with family, peers and community.

Adults

- General Adult (18 and over)
- Young Adult Treatment Tract (ages 18-24)
- Veteran/ Military Personnel Treatment Tract

Older Adults (55 and over or as clinically appropriate)

Separate unit meeting the unique physical, mental and emotional needs of the aging population. Psychiatrists and Internists specialized in geriatric services and interdisciplinary team that includes Occupational Therapy, Expressive Therapy, Nurses and Counselors.

PARTIAL PROGRAMS

The Partial Hospitalization Program provides a structured therapeutic day treatment option for **children** and **adolescents**. The goal of PHP is to help stabilize problematic behaviors and learn positive coping skills for patients who are struggling at home or at school, but are not requiring inpatient treatment.

COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

Our residential program treats up to 14 adolescent males (ages 16-21) who have exhibited sexually problematic behaviors and deal with a variety of mental health issues. The goal of the residential program is to instill long-term positive growth and change in the youth in its care.
