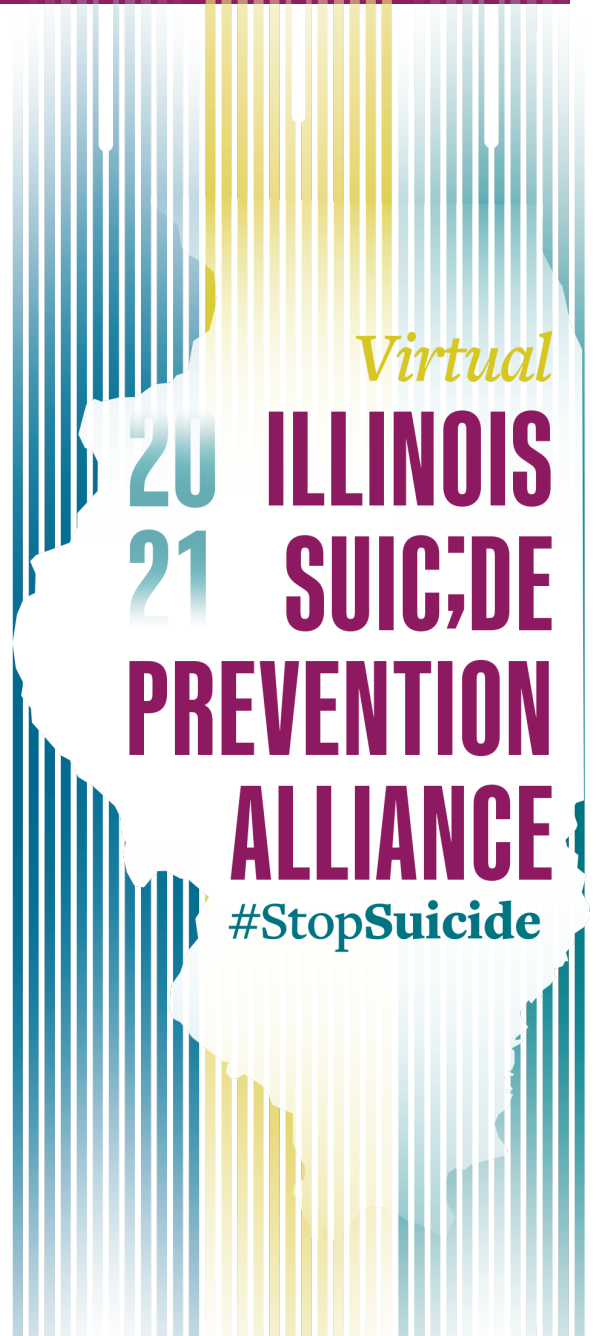
Keynote speaker:
